### **SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM**

Trustee	offered the follo	wing resolution and	moved for its adoption:

WHEREAS the eligible voting residents of the Village of Depew approved a referendum to establish a defined benefit Length of Service Award Program (a "LOSAP") for active volunteer firefighters of the Depew Fire Department in accordance with Article 11-A of the New York State General Municipal Law (GML);

WHEREAS the Village is the LOSAP Sponsor and Program Administrator;

WHEREAS GML § 216 authorizes the Village, as LOSAP Sponsor, to amend the LOSAP:

WHEREAS an active volunteer firefighter member currently earns a \$20 monthly Service Award for each year of Service Credit, payable at the Entitlement Age of sixty-two (62);

WHEREAS a participating active volunteer firefighter obtains a nonforfeitable right to a Service Award upon earning five (5) years of Service Credit, attaining the Entitlement Age of 62, or upon death or total and permanent disability;

WHEREAS under the current LOSAP provisions, the maximum number of years of Service Credit an active volunteer firefighter may earn is 30 years, which represents a maximum monthly Service Award of \$600;

WHEREAS a year of Service Credit is earned for each calendar year during which an active volunteer firefighter earns 50 or more points. Points are awarded for activities such as attending training sessions, participating in drills, responding to calls, being an officer, and more;

WHEREAS Chapter 400 of the Laws of 2021 amended GML § 219 to allow a LOSAP Sponsor to extend the maximum number of years of Service Credit for which a participating active volunteer firefighter may earn a Service Award to a maximum of 50 years;

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees desires to amend the LOSAP to extend the maximum years of Service Credit for which a participating active volunteer can earn a Service Award from 30 to 50 years; and

WHEREAS, this amendment is consistent with the intent of the LOSAP to recruit, retain and reward volunteer firefighters;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Depew, Towns of Cheektowaga and Lancaster, County of Erie, State of New York, as authorized by Article 11-A of the GML, approves an amendment to the LOSAP pursuant to Chapter 400 of the Laws of 2021 to extend the maximum years of Service Credit that may be earned under its LOSAP from 30 to 50 years and, therefore, the maximum projected monthly Service Award from \$600 to \$1,000, effective January 1, 2024. The normal funding contribution for the LOSAP is currently estimated to be about \$280,000. Of this total contribution, the component attributable to each participating volunteer firefighter that earns Service Credit averages about \$1,700. As a result of this amendment, the annual contribution requirement will increase by approximately \$25,000 to an estimated amount of \$305,000. The contribution per year of Service Credit earned will increase to an average of \$1,750. The Village pays an additional \$10,500 annually in actuarial, administrative and payment processing expenses which will not change as a result of this amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is subject to a mandatory referendum of qualified voters of the Village of Depew and said referendum shall be held on March 21, 2023, between the hours of 12 PM and 9 PM (prevailing time) at 85 Manitou Street Depew. NY 14043.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposition placed before the qualified voters read as follows:

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DEPEW, TOWNS OF CHEEKTOWAGA AND LANCASTER, COUNTY OF ERIE. STATE OF NEW YORK, IN A RESOLUTION ADOPTED FEBRUARY 13, 2023, APPROVED AN AMENDMENT OF THE DEFINED BENEFIT LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARD PROGRAM, ADMINISTERED BY THE VILLAGE AND ESTABLISHED FOR ACTIVE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS OF THE DEPEW FIRE DEPARTMENT, TO EXTEND THE MAXIMUM YEARS OF SERVICE CREDIT FOR WHICH A PARTICIPATING ACTIVE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER MAY EARN A SERVICE AWARD FROM 30 TO 50 YEARS AND, THEREFORE, THE MAXIMUM PROJECTED MONTHLY SERVICE AWARD FROM \$600 TO \$1.000, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2024.

THE NORMAL FUNDING CONTRIBUTION FOR THE PROGRAM IS CURRENTLY ABOUT \$280,000, WHICH INCLUDES AN AVERAGE CONTRIBUTION FOR EACH FIREFIGHTER THAT EARNS SERVICE CREDIT OF APPROXIMATELY \$1,700. AS A RESULT OF THIS AMENDMENT, THE ANNUAL REQUIRED CONTRIBUTION IS EXPECTED TO INCREASE BY \$25,000 TO APPROXIMATELY \$305,000, AND THE AVERAGE CONTRIBUTION FOR EACH PARTICIPATING VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER THAT EARNS SERVICE CREDIT WILL ALSO INCREASE TO ABOUT \$1,750. THE ADDITIONAL VILLAGE PAYS ANNUAL ACTUARIAL, ADMINISTRATIVE AND PAYMENT PROCESSING COSTS OF ABOUT \$10,500 WHICH WILL NOT CHANGE AS A RESULT OF THIS AMENDMENT.

SHALL THE STATED RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES BE APPROVED?

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the LOSAP shall continue to be administered by the Village and that all other provisions of the LOSAP shall remain the same.
