WHEREAS, in response to a resident complaint, Code Enforcement Officer Don Bielefeld conducted inspection of the residence at 73 Main Street, Depew, New York on November 15, 2022 and issued an Order to Remedy and Make Safe, and

WHEREAS, a re-inspection occurred on December 21, 2022 and January 6, 2023, in which none of the items listed in the Order to Remedy and Make Safe were corrected; and

WHEREAS, at the January 9, 2023 regular Board meeting, the Village Board of Trustees approved the demolition of 73 Main Street as an unsafe structure; and

WHEREAS, on the 21st Day of February, 2023, the Notice of Demolition was served pursuant to CPLR Section 308(4) to the owner, executor, administrator, agent, lessee or any person having a vested or contingent interest in such unsafe building as shown by the records of the Receiver of Taxes or of the County Clerk per Village Law Sections 81-6. 81-7, and 81-8, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held no less than 5 days after the notice of demolition was served, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 81 of the Depew Village Code and as noted in the Notice of Demolition, the structure was determined to be unsafe and the property owner has refused to comply,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Chapter 81 of the Depew Village Code, the unsafe condition and the property owner's refusal to comply require demolition of 73 Main Street, Depew, New York, and it is further
