SEQR – 124 GOULD AVE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Depew (hereinafter “Board”) having duly considered the application for the proposed construction of a 10,000 sq ft pre-engineered steel building to be used for an accessory fabrication shop located at 124 Gould Ave, Depew, New York (hereinafter the “project”) and that such proposed action may possibly be considered to have an effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Board by operation of law is the lead agency authorized to perform a review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (hereinafter “SEQRA”) pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law and undertook an UNCOORDINATED review and enlisted the services of appropriate consultants, specifically the Planning Board of the Village of Depew, to study and analyze the proposed action and provide professional opinions as to the classification of the nature of the proposed action for purposes of SEQRA; and

WHEREAS a comprehensive review of the proposed project has been completed and it has been determined that the project is an UNLISTED ACTION for purposes of SEQRA; and

WHEREAS a Short Environmental Assessment Form (SEAF) was reviewed, discussed, and completed during a special meeting of the Planning Board of the Village of Depew held on the 1st day of April, 2021 at which time the Planning Board reviewed the criteria and determined the significance of the project including the proposed action, its location, its purpose, and its potential impacts on the environment and issued the recommendation that the project be determined to be an UNLISTED ACTION for purposes of SEQRA .

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that as an UNLISTED ACTION under SEQR, the project has been found to categorically to not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and no further review under is SEQR is required, and it is further
