APPROVE PLANNING BOARD MEETING MINUTES – May 6, 2021

1. 42 S Warsaw, Matthew Dombrowski, requesting approval to subdivide the existing parcel to accommodate sale of existing building on southern portion of lot as per Chapter 260, §260-10 (C). Approved with stipulation that the addition of 16ft driveway entrance be shown on drawings submitted to Code Enforcement.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined that a safety issue occurs due to a lack of sight lines when cars are parked at the following corners of the Village of Depew:

1. West side of Candace 20 feet from George Urban
2. North side of French Rd. from Transit rd. to Lewan Drive
3. *Bellevue Ave- No Parking west side from Terrace to Gould - Recommend continuing west side restrictions from Terrace to Broadway*
4. *Ellington St- No restrictions - Recommend west side restrictions*
5. *Canton St- No Parking east side from Broadway to Terrace - Recommend no parking on west side from Gould to Broadway*
6. *River St- No Restrictions - Recommend restricting west side from Broadway to Gould Ave.*
7. *N. Bryant- No Restrictions - Recommend restricting west side from Broadway to Gould Ave.*
8. *Lackawanna- No Parking east side from Broadway to Terrace - Recommend no parking on west side from Broadway to Gould*
9. *Erie - No Parking east side along gravel lot*
10. *Lehigh- No Restrictions - Recommend restricting east side*
11. *A St- No Restrictions - Recommend restricting east side*
12. *Terrace- No Standing both north and south side, west of A St. - Recommend restricting north side from Transit to A St.*
13. *Gould - No Parking north side, west of Lackawanna*
